- Electrical and electronic waste
- Etc.

Sorting containers



GLASS PACKAGING

- Bottles
- Jam jars



METAL PACKAGING

- Fizzy drink/beer cans
- Tin cans



PAPER

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Copying paper
- Envelopes



CARDBOARD

- Cardboard packaging
- Brown corrugated cardboard



Everything thrown into the sorting container should be removed from the plastic bag

Located near the dog kennels

Only waste from holiday home toilets. All other waste from holiday homes is household waste and should be placed in the sorting or residual waste containers – or delivered to the Environmental Station. Holiday home waste **must** also be sorted.

Delivery to the Environmental Station

Household customers can deliver waste directly to the Environmental Station at no additional cost.

Please remember!

Waste should not be placed outside the containers and large items should be delivered to the Environmental Station.
